NUMBER PLATES ...DARK BACKGROUND <<BIG WHITE NUMBERS>>

NUMBER PLATES ...Visible from the front / Side's or Rear (quads)

NUMBER PLATES ...Unique Number 1 –99 (1st in at sign in gets the number.)

NUMBER PLATES ...No letters, No other colour backgrounds.

These will be checked before your practice and if they don't comply , you will be sent back to our pit to correct the fault.

Remember Please , also go slow on the access road Always wear your helmet and no casual riding around the pit's..
